Other examples

Niagara County park pavilion rental fees vary significantly by location, with examples including Krull Park (\$50-\$150) and [Oppenheim Park](#) (fees not specified), while [DeVeaux Woods State Park](#) costs \$60. In contrast, some city and town parks have different pricing structures. For instance, the Town of Wheatfield charges residents \$35-\$50 and non-residents \$55-\$70 depending on the pavilion size. The City of Tonawanda offers rentals from \$350-\$800 and residents have rates from \$350-\$550 for large pavilions like the [Ronald J. Pillozzi Pavilion](#).

Niagara County Parks

- [Krull Park](#):
 - Small shelters: \$50 (non-electric) to \$60 (with electric)
 - Large shelters: \$100 (non-electric) to \$125 (with electric)
 - Lions Shelter: \$150
- DeVeaux Woods State Park:
 - \$60 for a day use pavilion that accommodates up to 50 people.

City and Town Parks

- Town of Wheatfield: (Prices for 2024 are not specified, but likely similar to previous years)
 - Pavilion #1 (large): \$50 (resident) / \$70 (non-resident)
 - Pavilion #2 (small): \$35 (resident) / \$55 (non-resident)
 - Pavilion #3 (medium): \$45 (resident) / \$65 (non-resident)
 - Pavilion #4 (small): \$35 (resident) / \$55 (non-resident)
- [City of Tonawanda](#):
 - [Ronald J. Pillozzi Pavilion](#) (peak season, Fri-Sun): \$800 (non-resident) / \$550 (resident)
 - Ronald J. Pillozzi Pavilion (peak season, Mon-Thurs): \$600 (non-resident) / \$350 (resident)
- [Town of Pendleton](#):
 - Sunderland Pavilion: \$25 for a full-day reservation (residents only).
