RESOLUTION 1-26

Resolution Appointing Individual to Town Clerk Vacancy

WHEREAS, in accordance with New York Consolidated Laws, Town Laws, Article 3, Section 20, the Town of Pendleton shall have a town clerk; and

WHEREAS, the elected town clerk submitted a letter of resignation to the New York State Secretary of State, effective December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, New York Consolidated Laws, Town Laws, Article 4, Section 64 states that whenever a vacancy shall occur or exist in any town office, the town board or a majority of the members thereof, may appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, New York Consolidated Laws, Town Laws, Article 4, Section 64 further states that if the appointment be made to fill a vacancy in an elective office, the person so appointed shall hold office until the commencement of the calendar year next succeeding the first annual election at which the vacancy may be filled; and

WHEREAS, to ensure proper and efficient operation of all aspects of Town of Pendleton government, it is in the best interest of all to appoint an individual to the town clerk vacancy; and

WHEREAS, a well-qualified applicant has communicated her desire to serve as a town clerk under the conditions stipulated by New York Town Law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton on this 5th day of January 2026 that Noreen Lemma is appointed to the vacant town clerk position, with a term of office expiring on December 31, 2026. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION 5-26

Resolution Approving Contract

WHEREAS, under Section 135-a of the Highway Law, the Town Board is empowered to enter into written contracts with the Commissioner of Public Works acting as County Superintendent of Highways for the removal of snow and the sanding and treatment of pavement for ice control purposes, for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, such contracts have been negotiated by the Town Superintendent of Highways at the actual cost incurred by the Town per mile for removal of snow from County roads, and the control of ice at the actual cost incurred by the Town; therefore, be it, and it hereby is

RESOLVED, that the Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of Pendleton be empowered as an agent of the Town Board to enter into the attached Ice Control and Snow Removal Contracts with the Commissioner of Public Works acting as County Superintendent of Highways for a period of three (3) years.
